

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SIRIUS PUBLISHING

PC KARAOKE FAMILY FUN

"A wonderful unexpected blast of a good time!" say's the Computer Shopper, Its multi media Karaoke excitement for everyone as your voice is backed up by actual CD-Audio recordings that sound just like the original hits. And with PC KARAOKE's computer assisted annotation, anyone can sing like a professional in perfect time with the music. Step up to the mike and belt out a tune!



- ➤ Make sure you have 4MB of free hard disk space.
- ➤ Insert PC Karaoke: Family Fun into your CD-ROM drive.
- ➤ Under the Program Manager in Windows, select Run from the File menu.
- ➤ Type D:\setup.exe where "D" is the letter of the CD-ROM drive.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.
- > Start the program by double-clicking the PC Karaoke icon.



The main window is a menu of the different songs on the disc. Click once on the song title to start a song and press [Esc] to stop a song. The lower left corner is a Mixer Button and in the lower right is the Exit Button. To exit PC Karaoke, select the Exit Button from the main window.

MIXER CONTROLS

PC Karaoke directly links to many sound cards so you have access to volume controls within the program To run the PC Karaoke mixer, select the Mixer Button in the lower left corner of the main window. If a message appears at the bottom that says "THE SOUND CARD YOU HAVE CHOSEN DOES NOT SUPPORT INTERNAL MIXER CONTROLS", simply use the scroll arrows next to Unlisted Sound Card to select the sound card which your system supports. When the above message disappears, you will have access to microphone levels and volume controls from within PC Karaoke. Once the mixer control is set-up, the " Ω " and " \mathbb{Q} " kevs will control the master volume.



If you have multiple PC Karaoke CD's and wish to switch song discs, simply stop the current song and eject the disc from the drive when you're at the main window. The computer will prompt you to insert the new song disc.

Many systems do not have their MCI CD-Audio drivers automatically installed when the CD-ROM is installed. This will appear as a MCI error of varying types. To install it, use the Drivers icon under the Control Panel in the Main program group. Select [Add] and highlight [MCI] CD-Audio. Click [OK] and follow the

Information Icon Pictured as a question mark, choose Information when you need to be reminded what the various icons do in the game.

OBJECT CURSORS

Each item in your inventory has a special Object cursor. These can be used to perform game actions with your inventory items. Follow these steps:

- ➤ Choose the Inventory icon from the icon bar.
- Move the arrow to the inventory item you want to use and click. ➤ The cursor will change to look like the item you have selected.
- Click on "OK" and you will exit back to the game.
- ➤ Move the Object cursor to the place on screen where you want to use the inventory item and click.

CHEAT NOTES

Space Piston Safety Tip: AVOID THE CYBORGS!

Continue reading ONLY if you have trouble getting started playing Space Quest.

As you arrive on the streets of Xenon, click the EYE cursor on various locations on the screen to learn about your surroundings. Walk one screen East and click the HAND cursor on the rope in the lower right side of the screen. Avoid the Cyborg if he should appear, Walk between the red columns on the upper right side of the screen. Select the rope from your Inventory window and click the ROPE cursor on the ground. Wait for the bunny to walk into the noose, and click the HAND cursor on the rope. Walk two screens East. A Skimmer is parked on the street. Click the EYE cursor on the skimmer. Click the HAND cursor on the skimmer to search it. Click the HAND cursor on the glove box to open it, and click again to take the PocketPal inside. Walk one screen North. Click the EYE cursor on the hole in the side of the tank. Now would be a really good time to SAVE YOUR GAME!! Click the HAND on the unstable ordnance to take it. Walk two screens West, to the opposite street corner. Click the HAND cursor on the sewer grates, until you find one you can climb into. After you explode, restore your game and DON'T take the unstable ordnance. Return to the sewer grate, descend below the city, and enjoy the rest of the game!
