Introduction

What are InvisiClues?

Interactive fiction is partly a story for you to read and partly puzzles for you to solve. If you feel stuck on a puzzle at any point in the story, you can use this *InvisiClues* hint booklet. It will give you just enough hints so you can still solve the puzzle on your own. Or, if you don't want the thrill of solving it, this booklet will give you the whole answer. Either way, you can then continue in the story.

These hints are invisible. Usually the first hint after a question is just a nudge in the right direction, and the last one is a full answer. You can even learn a little just by reading the questions, but not much. Just to keep you guessing, we put in some extra questions and hints that have nothing to do with *Moonmist*. Beware!

How to use this booklet

If you feel stuck at some point in *Moonmist*, find the question that sounds most helpful. Uncap the marker and run it *once* over the first hint. The writing will appear in a second or two. If you still feel stumped after reading this hint and thinking about it, go on to the next hint. (Remember to recap the marker when you are done, or it will dry out. And by the way, *InvisiClues* that you read will begin to fade away after about six months.)
