

TIE BENCH

Techie Bench includes the most requested technical information for our current games. We hope this information will quickly and easily resolve any concerns you may have. If you need additional assistance, contact LucasArts Product Support by fax, letter, telephone or BBS (see "Where to Find Us").

Here are some suggestions for specific products:

TIE Fighter™

- ▶ Do you get a message saying you need more memory? Create a boot disk for your A: drive using the boot disk maker utility available by typing **INSTALL** at the TIE directory. Restart your machine with the boot disk in the A: drive. At the A:\>LucasBoot prompt, type: **cd \TIE <enter>**. Then type: **TIE <enter>** to start the game.

- ▶ Experiencing lockups? Check for a memory problem and make a boot disk if needed. Then reinstall the game into an *uncompressed* area of your hard drive.

- ▶ Did you get a stuck note with general midi sound? Select the SoundBlaster™ 2.0 setting for your sound card. We're working with sound card companies to create a patch.

Rebel Assault™ PC version

- ▶ If you're experiencing any problems, please create and use a boot disk for your A: drive using the boot disk maker utility available on your CD or on our BBS. If you have a joystick, don't load your mouse driver. Use the "joystick only" option. Next, check the CD for dirt or scratches, and clean the underside with a dry, clean cloth. If it still doesn't work, check out the following questions:

- ▶ Does the game run fine with no sound, or does the sound echo or have static? Refer to the sound card documentation and/or the sound card company's technical support staff regarding how to change the IRQ or DMA, or correct sound quality issues.

- ▶ Do you have an unexpected Interrupt/Bad IFF header message or poor joystick control? Download or order the *Rebel* patch.

- ▶ Lockups? This is usually an IRQ or DMA conflict. If the game still crashes when running with no sound, then use the *Rebel* patch.

- ▶ No sound at all? *Rebel Assault* only supports fully digitized sounds that operate solely in the DOS environment without memory management and on cards that are 100% SoundBlaster compatible. PC internal speakers, Adlib cards, Windows Sound Systems and other similar cards don't meet these requirements.

Rebel Assault Mac version

- ▶ Do you have an error message like "No CD in Drive" or "Bad IFF Header," or do you have joystick control problems? Download or order the *Rebel* Mac patch.

X-Wing™

- ▶ If your sound card needs to run on a port address other than 220, either order a patch from us or download it from a BBS. If you're experiencing memory concerns, remember to add your memory management device lines with at least one meg of *expanded* RAM allocated to your boot disk.



- ▶ Lockups or graphic/sound concerns? Simplify the interaction of the system: turn the modules down to **music once only**; reduce or eliminate sound choices; verify that you have the most updated video drivers, and are running under the 256 color VGA setting; and prudently save your work.

For additional assistance, please don't hesitate to contact us. For your convenience, if you can't get through to a representative by phone and you have access to a fax machine or can modem into our BBS or another online service, please consider doing so. When contacting us, be sure to include a complete printout of the config.sys and autoexec.bat files used for the game, the title and version of the game, and a detailed description of the problem. If you send a fax, include your name, return fax number with the area code, and a phone number so we can contact you if the transmission fails.



GEORGE LUCAS NAMED "FAMILY CHAMPION" BY WORKING MOTHER MAGAZINE

As part of its annual survey of best companies for working women, George Lucas was named "Family Champion" by Working Mother Magazine. The award acknowledges the benefits extended to women at Lucas' three companies, Lucasfilm, Lucas Digital and, of course, LucasArts. Among the benefits are on-site child care, flexible work schedules, sick days which can be applied to caring for an ill child, insurance coverage for domestic partners and dependents, and elder care resource and referral. On the heels of its summer successes, *The Flintstones*, *The Mask* and *Forrest Gump*, and having just completed special effects for George Lucas' *Radioland Murders*, ILM is working on two more movies for release in 1994. The first is *Star Trek Generations*, the seventh installment of the filmed series. For the movie, ILM is creating numerous computer-generated effects, as well as models of the Enterprise and the Klingon "Bird of Prey" starships. The other 1994 project is *Disclosure*, based on the Michael Crichton novel and starring Demi Moore and Michael Douglas. ILM is creating a "virtual reality" sequence for this film – or ILM's version of what v.r. should be, which is much more precise than how it currently exists.

For 1995, ILM already has completed several shots for John Carpenter's *In the Mouth of Madness*, and has begun work on Carpenter's next film, a remake of the cult classic *Village of the Damned*. Also in production are *Casper* (ILM's largest project to date with over 30 minutes of computer-generated character animation), *Indian in the Cupboard* and *Congo*.

ILM even has a head start on 1996 with work beginning on *Dragonheart*, starring Dennis Quaid and Sean Connery (as the voice of the dragon).

INDUSTRIAL LIGHT & MAGIC COMPUTER GRAPHICS VETERAN JOINS LUCASARTS AS CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER

ILM's senior manager for digital operations, Doug Kay, recently joined LucasArts as chief technical officer. Doug was instrumental in launching ILM's computer graphics department in 1985 and played an integral role in developing many of the technologies that pro-

pelled ILM to the top of its industry. Doug will now shift his focus away from film and toward interactive entertainment, providing technical direction to LucasArts' product development team, guiding the development of internal tools and assist-

ing the company in determining its future platform support.

"The fields of film making and visual effects are converging with interactive entertainment, particularly in the areas of production tools and values," said Doug. "Powerful work stations, like the kind we used at ILM to create the dinosaurs in *Jurassic Park*, are becoming more cost effective, and therefore accessible, to game developers. Additionally, the machines on which people play games are becoming more sophisticated and able to handle high-end graphics. At LucasArts I'll have the chance to apply what I've learned in 16 years in the visual effects field to an emerging industry where the possibilities are unlimited."

The Rebel Alliance, creators of the galaxy's greatest starfighters, now is incorporating a new technology into its fleet – CD-ROM. *X-Wing Collector's CD* for PC CD-ROM features all three games in the *X-Wing* family – *X-Wing*, *Imperial Pursuit*™ and *B-Wing*™ – plus new missions, enhanced graphics, and improved sound and speech.


Six new missions are integrated into the Historical Combat simulator. These battles bring all new excitement to the game. Players will engage the Alliance's staple ships in a variety of challenging battles against capital ships and fighters. Combined with the missions from the original titles, *X-Wing Collector's CD* offers more than 120 missions to fly.

X-Wing Collector's CD also updates many aspects of the original floppy games. The look of the various crafts is being improved with enhanced graphics. Gouraud shading, which was introduced in *TIE Fighter*, is being added to give the starfighters a more three dimensional and rounded appearance, adding to the realism of the environment.

Sound, as well as graphics, is being improved. Many digitized sound effects from the original movies are featured throughout the games. These include laser blasts, explosions and the roar of starfighter engines as they go screaming by. Adding to the sound experience, up to four sound effects can be played simultaneously, instead of only one as in the original version. Also, stereo panning adds to the feeling of ships zooming through space.

More than 1000 lines of

dialogue were recorded for the title. Now, mission briefings are presented in full digitized voice. Actor Clive Revill, the original voice of Emperor Palpatine in *The Empire Strikes Back*™, is the voice of General Dodonna, and Erik Bowersfeld, the voice of Admiral Ackbar in *Return of the Jedi*™, will reprise his role.

While *X-Wing Collector's CD* introduces numerous improvements to the original titles, the award-winning game play and story lines remain the same. In *X-Wing*, as a new pilot for the Rebel Alliance, players help squash the vast forces of Darth Vader and the Empire. Against the odds, players battle for freedom and face the Empire's ultimate weapon of destruction, the Death Star. *Imperial Pursuit* continues the struggle as players defend the remaining Rebel forces during their flight from the Death Star battle site. In *B-Wing*, players get to pilot a new Rebel starfighter and help the Rebellion search for a new base, eventually leading to the ice planet Hoth.

In *Dark Forces*, a brand new character is introduced into the Star Wars® fantasy...YOU. Finding the plans to the Death Star is only your *first* mission. After you've handed them over to the Rebel leaders, the familiar Star Wars characters continue on their trilogy while you branch off into your own Star Wars adventure, complete with all-new missions.

After securing the plans, you uncover another despicable plot by the Empire. It turns out there's a secret facility somewhere in the galaxy where a new army is being created – an army of deadly, mechanized stormtroopers that are unlimited in number and impervious to pain: dark troopers.

As your missions progress, you explore 14 different worlds, each with a distinct look and feel in terms of its architecture, graphics and attention to detail. *Dark Forces* project leader Daron Stinnett notes, “the worlds extend out in all directions. There are elevators to take you to multiple floors, bridges over flowing water, catwalks, air shafts and other architectural features. We wanted an active environment, so ships come and go at the flight decks, rivers sweep along, platforms and conveyor belts move, and much of the machinery functions.”

Dark Forces' Jedi Engine™ is a new, proprietary system developed internally by LucasArts. The Jedi

Engine supports full 3D objects, a realistic lighting model, atmospheric effects (haze, fog, etc.), gouraud shading, animating textures, 3D viewing angles and more. Lead programmer Ray Gresko states that working on this complex 3D engine was “one of my personal favorite accomplishments.”

These interactive environments are inhabited by a whole slew of Star Wars characters, some new and some very familiar. *Dark Forces* lead

artist/co-writer Justin Chin states, “many of the enemies are from the movies – Boba Fett, Gamorrean guards, the interrogation droid Leia encountered in the detention center, and the creature in the trash compactor – just to name a few.” As for the loathsome dark troopers, Justin wanted something unique. “Instead of just beefing up the stormtroopers, I designed dark troopers to be more efficient. I wanted something more terrifying and more omnipotent – something that would be used by the Imperial Army as a first-strike weapon.”

Ray designed all the enemies' artificial intelligence. “They're sort of my deadly children,” says Ray. “I teach them how to walk, attack and use weapons.”

Battling this battalion will take quick reflexes and superior aim. You'll have nine weapons (plus your





fists) at your disposal. Your arsenal can consist of laser pistols, thermal detonators, fusion cutters and other arms you find or take from enemies. Ray remarks, "I wanted the weapons to be as real as possible, so in some rooms you will see lasers ricochet off walls."

Dark Forces was painstakingly crafted with tools created by programmer Winston Wölff. "My primary objective was to give the artists flexibility and power in the way they design the environments," states Winston. "That's why in *Dark Forces*, you'll see rooms, chambers, halls and outdoor areas with unique shapes, textures and lighting. No two rooms will ever look alike."

The team also wanted to separate *Dark Forces* from other first person "shooter" games by adding large doses of strategy. The game features logic puzzles, as well as strategic timing scenarios. For instance, you must discover ways to extend bridges, rotate walls or otherwise manipulate your environment. And most important all this action runs very fast and



smoothly at a brisk 30 frames per second.

During game play, your alter-ego is extremely maneuverable. In addition to having 360 degree rotation, he can look up and down and execute enhanced movements such as jumping, ducking and crawling. In addition to your physical agility, you have other tools to assist you during your dangerous missions. You have use of a Personal Digital Assistant for easy access to briefings, as well as a Heads-Up Display for status evaluation and an auto-mapping function for quick location reference. The mapping function will come in very handy when trying to navigate the multi-layered, extensive locales of the game.

Daron sums it all up: "One of the greatest things about *Dark Forces* is that it's part action, part adventure and part exploration. It's not just about finding important or secret rooms and blowing away enemies. You can actually check out things you've seen in the movies." This winter players can look forward to running through a Star Destroyer or hanging out in Jabba the Hutt's palace. **ESC**

In a desolate future, justice is a tentative concept. Law and order, in the traditional sense, have disappeared, and in their place is the code

life – the destruction of Corley Motors, the last maker of the bikes that rule the road.



Corley was president of Corley Motors, the last manufacturer of the bikes that sustain Ben's way of life. Separated from his gang and on the run from the law, Ben must hunt down the true killer, clear his name and convince Corley's rebellious daughter to help him save a threatened institution. The game combines a compelling story with gripping action scenes, including explosive motorcycle gang conflicts, first-person on-the-road sequences, and a climactic showdown between the Polecats and the Vultures.





"Game players want to go to a place they can't really go to in their normal lives, they want to do things they can't really do, and they want to be someone they aren't – just for a little while," says Tim Schafer, *Full Throttle* project leader. "The reason bikers lept out at me is that they have a whole world associated with them, but it's not a commonplace environment. It's a fantastic, bizarre, wild, larger-than-life environment – perfect for an adventure game."


Full-screen graphics make *Full Throttle* leap off the monitor. The cinematic adventure mixes third- and first-person perspectives, uses a variety of camera angles to create dramatic effects, and seamlessly blends 3D and 2D animation to impose a sense of realism in an animated, surrealistic setting. The SCUMM™ engine has been tuned up for *Full Throttle*, with one of the most notable changes being the integration of INSANE™ (Interactive Streaming ANimation Engine) – the engine used in *Rebel Assault*. The result is the addition of exhilarating, action sequences similar to the Death Star trench run in *Rebel*. In these 3D-rendered scenes, the camera follows Ben as he tears down the road on his bike.

As Ben cruises the highways, he encounters rival gang members – most of whom are none too pleased to make his acquaintance. At these junctures, he can ignore or confront them. If the player chooses to challenge, then the view swings to the front where we see the two bikers side by side as the background races by. The player now gets control of Ben's fighting moves and can attempt to force his adversaries off the road.

Full Throttle features more than a dozen highly-detailed, futuristic vehicles, all ren-

dered in 3D. These include motorcycles, limos, trucks and even a gigantic cargo plane. A built-in *Full Throttle* screen saver will display these vehicles whenever players need a break to make a trip to the rest area. The game's sound track further intensifies the action with full-speech, digital sound effects and a digital music score.

"I'm most proud of the risks we took with this game," says Tim. "We knew exactly how to make a game just like *Day of the Tentacle*, but we tried for something completely different instead. We didn't stay with a safe genre – we made one up. We didn't stay with a safe interface – we experimented. We didn't stay with safe technology – we pushed the engine even further. All of that meant twice the work, but in the end we'll have so much more to show



for it. No matter what, you always kill yourself to get a game out, so you might as well make the end product worth the effort."




Defender of the Empire™

The most fearsome enemy is one that was once an ally. The Empire learns this harsh lesson as it defends itself and its starfighter fleet against the traitorous attacks of its former chief technology officer, the cunning Admiral Zaarin. In *TIE Fighter*, Zaarin's initial attempts at overthrowing Emperor Palpatine were thwarted, but his forces have grown in number and strength. Between Zaarin's attacks, pirates scheming to benefit from the internal turmoil and, of course, the Rebel Alliance poised to strike the Empire in its distracted state, the Emperor has his hands full. It will take the Empire's most dedicated and skilled pilots to save it from ruin and secure its position as the most powerful force in the galaxy.

Defender of the Empire is the first Campaign expansion disk for the successful Star Wars space combat simulator, *TIE Fighter*. In *Defender of the Empire* the Empire must continue to defend itself against the traitor, Zaarin, as he schemes to commandeer various TIE manufacturing facilities and build his own army. At the same time, pirates

loom like vultures and the Rebel Alliance is ready to attack.

Defender of the Empire features a new *TIE Fighter* Campaign comprised of three battles. The title has 18 missions which are punctuated by four highly animated, cinematic cut scenes. 


When did you start working at LucasArts?

► I started working for LucasArts as an independent contractor in 1991 composing music for *Indiana Jones and the Fate of Atlantis*® and *Monkey Island 2: LeChuck's Revenge*®. At that time, two other composers were already here, Michael Land and Peter McConnell. I've since joined the team on a full-time basis.

What do you like best about your job?

► I like the challenge of pushing sound and music in games to higher and higher levels of quality with each product. I'm always trying to create material of higher quality by industry standards, as well as outperform my own prior achievements. Tell us your best LucasArts "war story."

► We needed some high anxiety music that we called "Panic" for *TIE Fighter*. As the project deadline approached and we still had only sketches for it, I composed it in just a few hours out of the same emotion I was attempting to capture!

Tell us a little bit about what you're working on now?

► I'm currently scoring *Dark Forces* with sound and music, and enjoying the process of working with a very fine development team. I will soon be scoring *Full Throttle* with sound effects, which I'm sure will turn out to be a real creative challenge.

What is your favorite LucasArts game? Why?

► Although I really like the Star Wars action games, my favorite LucasArts game would have to be *Indiana Jones and the Fate of Atlantis* for its tremendous story. There should be a movie made out of that!

Where is your favorite vacation spot?

► The Mediterranean region. I love Italy, Greece and Turkey a great deal, especially for their archaeological sites.

What do you like to do when you're not at work?

► I like to relax and hike in the Marin countryside with my wife, Deniz. Sometimes I play guitar or keyboards with other musicians for pleasure.

Who are your heroes? Why?

► I look to film composer John Williams as an exemplary artist. He adds a strong element of emotion and drama to film that could only be achieved through music of exceptional quality. In our own way, that's what the sound and music team here at LucasArts tries to accomplish for games. **ESC**

► Well, last year was a big challenge helping to turn out *Sam & Max Hit the Road* in an unprecedented seven

and a half months of actual production time, while continuing to manage the art department at the same time. We were in crunch mode from day one. Some of us still haven't quite recovered. Tell us a little bit about what you're working on now.

► I'm working on a new project that has yet to be announced. It's based on my idea, and I'm project leading it. All I can say is that it will be for a different audience than most of our games and

will hopefully be very cool and fun.

What is your favorite LucasArts game? Why?

► I have to say that *Monkey Island*® is a sentimental favorite of mine. There are so many great things about it – the graphics, the story and, most of all, the humor. It's also one of the biggest reasons I came to work here.

Where is your favorite vacation spot?

► It's a toss up between Mendocino and Santa Cruz. I love driving up north along Highway 1 to Mendocino and staying at a cozy B&B. But on the other hand, nothing beats the roller coaster at the Santa Cruz boardwalk!

Who are your heroes? Why?


