The Orb of Carnos has been stolen by the Dark Wizard. The Kingdom suffers from blight, disease, confusion and senseless infighting. To set matters right again, you must enter the Dark Wizard's dungeon and recover the Orb, hidden deep within. Each of the dungeon's forty levels is a challenging maze...each level more difficult than the one before. Beasts attack you all the way down (and up again), but everything you need to survive is there, somewhere, including armor, weapons, potions, scrolls, rings, wands, gems and food.

You can enter the dungeon as one of seven types of brave characters — Wizard, Knight, Fighter, Alchemist, Jeweler, Sage, or Jones (a "Jack of All Trades"). Each begins with different advantages in terms of strength, wisdom, dexterity, charisma, intelligence and constitution, and each is better at using certain objects in the dungeon. The "Rumors" included may help you determine who is best at what, but *The Carnos Chronicles* (available separately) will tell you even more. Upon your character's escape...or death...his adventure is recorded in the Hall of Legends, which can be erased whenever you wish. And although you may escape, *The Dungeon Revealed* never quits — each game is randomly created, so no two games are ever the same!

The Dungeon Revealed began as the "shareware" classic *The Dungeon of Doom*, often cited as one of the best Macintosh games. Now, with the best features of "D of D" and many new ones, *The Dungeon Revealed* is sure to hold a special place in your software collection:
