ULTIMA VIII PAGAN SPEECH PACK Install Guide

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

To use the Speech Pack for Ultima VIII Pagan, you must first:

- 1. Install a *Sound Blaster*, *Sound Blaster Pro*, *Sound Blaster 16/16ASP* or 100% compatible digitized sound card.
- 2. Install *Ultima VIII Pagan* on your machine. If you have not installed *Ultima VIII Pagan*, stop and install the game before continuing with the *Speech Pack* installation.
- 3. Make sure you have at least 7 megs of additional space available on the same drive on which *Ultima VIII Pagan* is installed.

Note: You can install the *Speech Pack* onto your hard drive even if you do not have a Sound Blaster or 100% compatible sound card installed in your machine. However, you won't be able to hear speech until you install a Sound Blaster compatible card and re-run the *Ultima VIII Pagan* install program to let the game know that you've changed your configuration. Consult the *Ultima VIII Pagan Install Guide* for further information.

Note: The Ultima VIII Pagan Speech Pack only adds speech to the Titans, three Zealans, Khumash-Gor and the Guardian.

INSTALLATION

The Speech Pack install program does the following two things:

- 1. It asks you where your *Ultima VIII Pagan* files are located (both the drive and the directory).
- 2. It copies the speech files from the *Speech Pack* disks to your hard drive, decompressing them in the process.

INSTALLING THE SPEECH PACK

- 1. Insert Disk 1 of the *Speech Pack* into the appropriate drive.
- 2. Type the name of the floppy drive (A: or B:), then press *Enter*.
- 3. Type SPEECH and press Enter.

4. **The Installation Screen** This lists a Source Drive and a Destination Drive with a default directory (C:\ULTIMA8).

If you accepted the default directory that *Ultima VIII Pagan* and *Speech Pack* install programs suggested (C:\ULTIMA8):

Use 🕈 and 🕒 to highlight INSTALL

Press (Enter)

Continue with Step 6.

If you chose another directory, follow Step 5.

5. Selecting the Path/Change Destination Path

If you installed *Ultima VIII Pagan* in a different directory:

Use
↑ and
↓ to highlight CHANGE DESTINATION PATH Press *Enter ← Backspace* over current destination path Type the full path you chose when you installed *Ultima VIII Pagan* Press *Enter* Use
↑ and
↓ to highlight INSTALL Press *Enter*

Continue with Step 6.

If the *Speech Pack* install program cannot find *Ultima VIII Pagan* in the location specified, you will be asked to enter a new drive and path. If you continue to have trouble and are sure that you typed the correct path, please contact our Technical Support department at the phone number below.

6. Copying the Files

Once the install program has confirmed the location of your game, it begins copying and decompressing the speech files onto your hard drive.

At this time you are prompted to insert the remaining disks from the *Speech Pack*. Continue as prompted until all files are copied to your hard drive.

7. Beginning Play

When the installation process is finished, make sure that you are in your

Ultima VIII Pagan game directory, then type U8 *Enter* to begin play.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Q: Ultima VIII Pagan fails to load or run and generates an error code. What's wrong with my game?

A: Certain error messages can easily be interpreted and remedied:

1. HALTING: INTERNAL ERROR! WHERE: INSTALL.C - 198 or 196 REASON: *Ultima VIII* NOT FOUND IN DESTINATION DIRECTORY.

You may have selected the wrong destination drive or directory during the installation of the *Speech Pack* – verify that the destination and directory you chose are where *Ultima VIII Pagan* was installed. A corrupted copy of *Ultima VIII Pagan* may also be the cause – see **Troubleshooting**: **Checking Your Installation** in the *Ultima VIII Pagan Install Guide*.

- HALTING: INTERNAL ERROR! WHERE: INSTALL.C - 251 REASON: USER ABORT
 You pressed *[Esc]* during the installation and should re-install the Ultima VIII Speech Pack.
- 3. HALTING: INTERNAL ERROR! WHERE: INSTALL.C - 261 REASON: ERROR #0001

This error message indicates that you have a bad or corrupted diskette. You should either ask for an exchange with the software retailer from whom you purchased the *Speech Pack*, or review the warranty information listed below or call Technical Support.

If you experience any difficulties after installation, run the U8 -Test program (see Troubleshooting: Checking Your Installation in the Ultima VIII Pagan Install Guide) to ensure that the game is properly installed to use your speech card. Use the Ultima VIII Pagan install program to confirm that you have the appropriate sound card selected.
