Getting Started

On a MS-DOS Computer

Boot DOS 2.1 or above, and go to drive A. Type INSTALL and press return. Follow
the on-screen directions for your hardware or see the explanation below.

Special note for Tandy

Tandy owners will need to upgrade their machine with an EGA card to display graphics since the EGA process differs from the 16-color graphics capabilities that Tandy computers have.

3.5" Disk Users

 CORRUPTION is not protected for your convenience and can be transferred to run from a 3.5" disk without any problems.

INSTALL PROGRAM

- Single Floppy Owners
 - 1. Single drive, text version: type CORRUPTI and press return.
 - 2. Single drive, 40 column text version: type CORRUPTI / 4 and press return.
 - 3. Single drive, EGA version without mouse: type CORRUPTI / G / N and press return.
 - 4. Single drive, EGA version with mouse: type CORRUPTI / G and press return.

· Two Drive Owners

To install CORRUPTION for two drives: put disk one in drive A and put disk one in drive B

- 1. Two drives, text version: type INSTALL / T A: B: and press return.
- 2. Two drives, 40 column text version: type INSTALL / 4 A: B: and press return.
- 3. Two drives, EGA vesion without mouse: type INSTALL / G A: B: / N and press return.

 4. Two drives, EGA version with mouse: type INSTALL / G A: B: and press return.

· Hard disk Owners

- 1. Hard drive, text version: type INSTALL / T C: and press return.
- 2. Hard drive, 40 column text version: type INSTALL / 4 C: and press return.
- 3. Hard drive, EGA version without mouse: type INSTALL / G C: / N and press return.
- 4. Hard drive, EGA version with mouse: type INSTALL / G C: and press return.

On an Amiga 500 & 2000

 Turn on your computer. When you see the Workbench prompt, insert your CORRUPTION disk. The game will begin loading.

On an Amiga 1000

Turn on your computer. When you are prompted, insert your Kickstart 1.2 or higher.
 When you see the Workbench prompt, remove your Kickstart disk and insert your CORRUPTION disk.

On Atari ST

· Turn on your computer with CORRUPTION disk in your drive. The game will begin loading.
